proceedings which may be had in reference to any road or bridge in that district, and they are hereby authorized to provide such book as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this law, and pay the cost thereof out of the general road fund hereinafter provided.

SEC. 8. And be it enacted, The Road Commissioners herein provided for shall take charge of all the roads and bridges in their respective districts, and shall see that no obstruction, hindrance or injury is struction. permitted upon any road or bridge under their supervision; and when any road or bridge shall form the boundary between districts, the County Commismissioners shall assign to each district its portion of said road or bridge.

Prevent ob-

Sec. 9. And be it enacted, The opening, construction and repair of new roads, the closing and changing the location and repair of all roads, shall be location. within the control of the Board of Commissioners of that district in which they are situated, subject to approval of the County Commissioners.

Sec. 10. And be it enacted, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county shall annually levy upon the assessable property of Baltimore county at taxes. the time of making the county levy, a sum of money not less than ten nor more than fifteen cents on the one hundred dollars, for the use of public roads and bridges in Baltimore county, which shall be collected as other county taxes are collected.

SEC. 11. And be it enacted, That the County Commissioners shall set apart two-thirds of the tax so collected as a special road and bridge fund, which posed of. shall be for the use and benefit of that district from which it has been collected, and for no other purpose, and all orders for the payment of money shall be signed by the chairman and at least one other commissioner of that district. The County Commissioners shall set apart the remaining one-third of the tax so collected as a general road and bridge fund, which shall be applied by the County Commissioners to the general use and benefit of the bridges and roads of Baltimore county, and for no other purposes.
