

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall not be lawful for any person to shoot at, or shoot any ducks or other wild fowl on or over the waters of West or Rhode rivers and their creeks, except from the natural shores of said West and Rhode rivers and their creeks, or from blinds placed in said waters, and said blinds not to be within five hundred yards of each other. Unlawful to shoot ducks, &c.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That it shall not be lawful to shoot on said rivers, except on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. When to shoot.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

## CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT relating to Justices of the Peace in and for Carroll county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall not be lawful for any resident of Carroll county to be sued before any Justice of the Peace of said county out of the election district in which he or she resides; provided, however, that upon any cause of action within the jurisdiction of a Justice of the Peace arising in said county, any resident may be sued before a Justice of the Peace in the election district wherein the contract was made and such cause of action did originate, and provided further, that when any cause of action arises in any other county or the city of Baltimore, suit may be brought before any Justice of the Peace in the county, and provided that where there are two or more defendants residing in different districts, it shall be lawful to institute proceedings in any district in which any defendant resides. Unlawful to sue out of election district

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
