

CHAPTER 341.

AN ACT to amend article forty-four of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Hospital, Maryland," as the same was amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter three hundred and fifty-one, entitled "An act to repeal sections one to thirteen, both inclusive, of article forty-four of the Code of Public General Laws," title "Maryland Hospital," and to enact in lieu thereof the following, to be arranged as sections of said article of the Code, by amending section four of said article, and by re-enacting said section four as amended, and by adding an additional section to said article forty-four, as so amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter three hundred and fifty-one.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section four of article forty-four of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Hospital, Maryland," as the same was amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter three hundred and fifty-one, entitled "An act to repeal sections one to thirteen, both inclusive, of article forty-four, of the Code of Public General Laws," title "Maryland Hospital," and to enact in lieu thereof the following as sections of said article of the Code, be and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted, so that the same shall read as follows:

Amended and re-enacted.

Appoint treasurer.

Appoint superintendent, &c.

4. The Board of Managers shall appoint one of its number, who shall act as treasurer, who shall give bond for the faithful performance of his trust, in such sum and in such sureties as the Comptroller of the State shall approve; they shall also appoint a superintendent, who shall be a well educated physician, and in addition shall also appoint as many physicians, surgeons, apothecaries, stewards, matrons, nurses, servants and other officers for the adminis-
