Company continues to be the owner of the stock of said railroad company; provided said railroad company continues to pay the State tax upon its gross receipts as required by the laws of this State.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 343. •

AN ACT to repeal section one of an act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and fifty three of the General Assembly of Maryland, entitled "An act to amend an act entitled an act to establish a House of Refuge for Juvenile Delinquents and supplements thereto," so as to reduce the number of managers thereof, and to reenact the same with amendments, so as to read as follows:

Re-enacted with amend-ments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one of the act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and fifty-three of the General Assembly of Maryland, entitled "An act to amend an act entitled an act to establish a House of Refuge for Juvenile Delinquents and supplements thereto," so as to reduce the number of managers thereof, be and is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

SEC. 1. And be it enacted, That the number of managers of the House of Refuge shall be fifteen instead of twenty-four, as now prescribed by law, and of whom five shall be appointed by the Governor, by and with the consent of the Senate; five
