

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the holders of said orders, checks or drafts failing to present the same to the County Commissioners as provided for in the first section of this act, shall not be entitled to receive or demand of, or from said collectors, any interest on the same after the time hereinbefore provided for the presentment thereof, nor shall any interest be collectable on said orders, checks or drafts when held by persons who refuse to accept from said collector payment thereof, after payment has been tendered by said collectors.

When interest stops.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT to repeal section one of chapter one hundred and seventy-six of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to grant donations to Garrett county for the use of Academies and Schools," and to amend and re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one of chapter one hundred and seventy-six of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to grant donations to Garrett county for the use of Academies and Schools," be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Amended and re-enacted.

1. That the Treasurer of the State, upon the warrant of the comptroller, shall pay annually on the first Monday of July, to the Board of School Commissioners of Garrett county, the sum of twelve hundred dollars, to be applied to the Public School Fund of said county; the said sum of twelve hundred dollars shall
