

CHAPTER 353.

AN ACT to refund to John S. Walters, of Caroline county, a sum of money erroneously paid by him into the treasury of the State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant on the Treasurer of Maryland, to pay John S. Walters, of Caroline county, the sum of fifty dollars for liquor and oyster house license, erroneously paid by him into the treasury of the State. R e f u n d

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 354.

AN ACT directing the Comptroller to issue his warrant to the Treasurer to pay John W. Denton and Zachariah Bowen for services rendered by them respectively in the State Tobacco Warehouse No. two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant to the Treasurer to pay to John W. Denton the sum of thirty-three dollars and sixty cents for services as screwman in the State Tobacco Warehouse "Number two," and to pay to Zachariah Bowen the sum of three hundred and one dollars and fifty cents for services as Deputy Inspector in said warehouse.
