

CHAPTER 356.

AN ACT to repeal section ninety of article twelve of the Public Local Laws, title "Harford County," sub-title "Notices," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section ninety of article twelve of the Public Local Laws, title "Harford County," sub-title "Notices," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows: Repealed and re-enacted.

90. All notices concerning the opening, altering, locating or widening any public road, all reports of the School Commissioners that are required to be published, all lists of county expenses, and levies and notices or other papers issuing from the County Commissioners required by law to be published, shall be published in at least two newspapers printed in the county. Publish in two newspapers.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 357.

AN ACT to authorize the appointment of an additional justice of the peace in and for the fifth district of Talbot county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That, in addition to the justices of the peace of the fifth district of Talbot county as now provided by law, there shall be an additional justice of the peace appointed for said fifth district of Talbot county. Additional justice.
