

shall have effect from the first day of June in the year in which it may have been obtained to the first day of June succeeding, and shall authorize the use of said canoe or boat in taking or catching oysters on either side of the dividing channel of said river for sale to any person; provided that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to conflict with the rights of owners or occupants of lands bordering on said river as are secured and protected under existing laws.

CHAPTER 360.

AN ACT to add two additional sections to article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Kent County," to be known as sections two hundred and twenty-one and two hundred and twenty-two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the two following sections be added to article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Kent County," to be known as sections two hundred and twenty-one and two hundred and twenty-two.

Additional sections.

SEC. 221. *And be it enacted,* That the cemetery or graveyard within the limits of Chestertown, adjoining the public square contiguous to the courthouse, be and the same is hereby placed under the exclusive government and control of the County Commissioners for Kent county, who shall have power to remove any wall or fence on the same so as to enlarge the public grounds; to enclose all the said grounds and public square in such secure manner as they deem necessary or proper, and in their name, as County Commissioners for Kent county, may sue and recover for any trespass or injury to the inclosures, trees, bushes, grass, flowers, grounds
