

nineteen, be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following sub-sections thereto :

SUB-SEC. 3. It shall not be lawful for any person or persons whatsoever to haul in the waters of the Patuxent river, between Sheridan's point and Point Patience, any seine of greater length than sixty fathoms, at any time between the first day of June and the first day of October following. When unlawful.

SUB-SEC. 4. Any person violating the provisions of this last-mentioned section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before a justice of the peace for Calvert county, or before the Circuit Court of Calvert county, shall be fined a sum not less than twenty dollars nor more than fifty dollars, one half thereof to be paid to the informer and the other half thereof to the County Commissioners of said county. May be fined.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 364.

AN ACT to repeal section eleven of article thirty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section eleven of article thirty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers," be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows : Repealed and re-enacted.
