

Penalty for violation.      forfeiture of boat used in said violation, and for every subsequent violation a forfeiture of twenty dollars and costs shall be imposed, together with the forfeiture of the boat employed in said violation, the same to be recovered before any justice of the peace within said county, and the boat or boats captured under the provisions of this act shall immediately be advertised by printed or written hand-bills, and sold at public sale to the highest bidder for cash in ten days thereafter; and the money arising from said sale and fines, after deducting the legal costs, shall be paid into the free school treasury of Dorchester county, for the use of said schools; provided nothing herein contained shall prevent any person who may be aggrieved by the decision of the justice of the peace from appealing to the Circuit Court, if such appeals are taken and satisfactory bond filed for prosecuting said appeal with the justice of the peace within five days after the fine and capture of boat.

CHAPTER 367.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and ninety-two of the acts passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to revive and extend an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed December session, eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter sixty-eight, entitled 'An act to incorporate the Trustees of Buckingham Academy and Female Seminary of Berlin,'" and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter one hundred and ninety-two of the acts passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to revive and extend an Act of the General Assembly of
