

Maryland, passed December session, eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter sixty-eight, entitled 'An act to incorporate the Trustees of Buckingham Academy and Female Seminary of Berlin,' be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Whereas the Trustees of the Buckingham Academy and Female Seminary of Berlin, by neglecting to as provided for in their act of incorporation may have forfeited their corporate powers ; and

Whereas it is necessary that said act should be revived and extended in order to preserve the rever- sionary right of the trustees in and to the property ; therefore,

1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act entitled "An act to incorporate the Trustees of Buckingham Academy and Female Seminary of Berlin," passed December session, eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter sixty-eight, be and the same is hereby revived and extended until altered or annulled by the General Assembly.

2. *And be it enacted,* That John S. Purnell, Robert J. Henry, H. R. Pitts, Wm. D. Pitts, Cyrus L. Williams, L. D. Powell, John R. Purnell, John T. Hammond, Levin L. Dirickson and Zadok P. Henry, the present Board of Trustees, shall exercise all the rights, privileges and powers conferred by said act upon the original Board of Trustees, and the office of said trustees shall not become vacant on account of failure to attend the meetings of said board.

3. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
