

CHAPTER 378.

AN ACT to repeal section seventy-two of article five of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Calvert County," sub-title "Sheriff," as amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy four, chapter four hundred and seventeen, and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows :

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section seventy-two of article five of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Calvert County," sub-title "Sheriff," as amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter four hundred and seventeen, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Repealed and re-enacted.

72. The sheriff of Calvert county shall receive forty cents a day for keeping and boarding each prisoner in jail, and shall also receive a sum of money, not to exceed forty dollars, for conveying to the State penitentiary, or to any other place of punishment situated beyond the limits of said county, every person sentenced thereto by the Circuit Court for Calvert county.

Compensat'n to sheriff.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 379.

AN ACT to provide for the reference of disputes between employers and employees to arbitration.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland;* That whenever any controversy shall arise between any corporation incorporated by
