

more than six months after the death of said Samuel Vickers, did do and perform said work, under an agreement with said successor that he was to receive the proceeds arising from same to compensate therefor, and when it was believed that the estate of said Samuel Vickers was sufficient to pay therefor; and

Preamble. Whereas it afterwards appearing that said Samuel Vickers left no estate from which payment therefor could be had or made, and said Robert Goldsborough has never been compensated for said work, and had it not been done by him it would necessarily have been done at the expense of the county at some subsequent time; therefore,

Commissioners to levy. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of said county be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to levy upon the assessable property of said county a sum sufficient to pay said Robert Goldsborough for said work so performed as aforesaid by him, and as the same will appear from a probated account therefor, which he is hereby required to furnish said commissioners, not to exceed the sum of ninety dollars.

CHAPTER 381.

AN ACT to authorize the Register of Wills for Queen Anne's county to do and perform certain work left unfinished by a former Register of Wills of said county.

Preamble. Whereas a former Register of Wills for Queen Anne's county has departed this life, leaving certain work unfinished and incomplete, and leaving no estate out of which payment for the performance of said work could be had or made; and
