

Whereas more than six months have elapsed since the said Register of Wills departed this life, and said work is still unfinished, and it is of public importance that the same shall be done without further delay; therefore, Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Register of Wills of said county be and he is hereby authorized, in his discretion, to do and perform said unfinished work. Complete unfinished work

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners of said county be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to levy upon the assessable property of said county a sufficient sum to pay for the expenses of doing and performing said work not exceeding one hundred dollars. Commissioner to levy.

CHAPTER 382.

AN ACT to repeal section thirty-four of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Harford county," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section thirty-four of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Harford county," sub-title "County Commissioner," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows : Repealed and re-enacted.

34. The County Commissioners of Harford county shall levy annually such sum of money as they may deem sufficient to pay the expenses which may be annually incurred by the attendance of jurors, bailiffs, crier and witnesses for the State, and for the defendant if acquitted, in criminal cases in the Circuit Court for Harford county and said commis- Commissioner to levy.
