SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer for two hundred and fifty dollars to Mary E. CHAPTER 386.

AN ACT to repeal sections one, five and thirteen of chapter thirty-six of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled "An act to add a new article to the Code of Public General Laws, regulating the inspections of tobacco," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
