Penalty for violation.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the owner or owners of any and every horse or mule, of each head of cattle, sheep and swine found trespassing under this act, shall be made to pay a fine for each offence per head; for horses and mules and cattle, fifty cents; for sheep and hogs, twenty cents, to be collected as fines, penalties and forfeitures are collected under article forty, section one, of the Code of Public General Laws.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That any owner or Entitled to owners of stock taken up under this act, shall have the privilege of a fair hearing before any justice of hearing. the peace of the election district hereinbefore named.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the fines specified in section two of this act shall be paid, one-fourth Fines-how to the informer, one-fourth to the constable in the applied. case, and the remainder to the Board of County School Commissioners, to be by them applied to the Public School Fund of said county.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall not When not apply in any case where the owner or owners of applicable. stock found trespassing as above named shall make it appear satisfactorily to the justice of the peace in the case that he or they (said owner or owners), cannot justly be held responsible for the trespass, inasmuch as he or they had employed all reasonable means to prevent it, and that said trespass had occurred through some agency over which said owner or owners could exercise no control.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That this act shall not Not to apply apply to any stock being driven from point to point to stock when on the public roads or public grounds in school disdriven. trict aforesaid, when such stock shall be under proper guard.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That any one who shall be found guilty before any justice of the peace of the county aforesaid of purposely turning out stock, Aiding stock or of opening gates, or in any other way aiding any stock of the character specified in this act, to trespass to the extent of a violation of this act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than five dollars, to be collected as other fines are collected under this act,
