

or imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding seven days, and any fine collected under this section shall be paid one-half to the informer and the other half into the county treasury aforesaid.

CHAPTER 389.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the Governor of this State to appoint an additional justice of the peace in and for Somerset county, in Princess Ann District, or election district number one.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Governor of this State be and he is hereby authorized and directed to appoint ^{Additional,} justice. an additional justice of the peace in and for Somerset county, in Princess Ann District, or election district number one.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take In force. effect from its passage.

CHAPTER 390.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor, Counsellor and Aldermen of the city of Annapolis to issue bonds on the credit of the city to pay its debts.
