

or the acceptance of any such deed, shall be and be deemed a covenant by the trustees of the Presbyterian Church in Hagerstown with the heirs of the said Hugh Kennedy or John Kennedy, and each of them, that the one-fourth part of the purchase money arising from any sale of said land, or any part thereof, by the trustees of the Presbyterian Church in Hagerstown, shall be appropriated to the use of and to the keeping in order perpetually the cemetery or grave-yard now on said land, and the said one-fourth part of the purchase money shall be held by the purchaser or purchasers, or such person or body corporate as he or they may by deed appoint in trust for said purpose, the principal to be invested safely, and the interest only to be used. How appropriated.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That this act shall take effect from its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 395.

AN ACT to incorporate the Port Deposit Detective Association.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That J. H. Rowland, F. S. Everest, J. R. Miller, William M. Loag, John Keaveny, K. Katz, Benjamin Gifford, and all and every person or persons with them, or in their stead, shall hereafter become associated with them, their successors and assigns, shall be and are hereby created and declared to be a body corporate and politic, by the name and style of the Port Deposit Detective Association, and by that name shall and may have perpetual succession and be capable in law of purchasing, holding, improving and disposing of such property, real, personal and mixed, as may be necessary for the purposes herein authorized; and may sue Body corporate
