

How awarded erection of the new, and award the erection and repairs to the lowest bidder, if in their judgment they deem the same expedient; provided the erection and repair, and all expenses incident to such repair and addition, shall not exceed the sum of five thousand dollars.

**Furnish bond** SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners, before accepting any bid for the erection of the new addition and repairs of the old jail, shall require the bidder to enter into a good bond, in the sum of ten thousand dollars, for the faithful performance of said repairs and the erection of said addition to said jail.

**Levy special tax.** SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That at the next regular levy-laying term of said County Commissioners after the passage of this act, they shall levy a special tax sufficient to defray all the costs and expenses of the work hereby authorized, and of all incidental expenses necessary to the carrying out of the provisions of this act; provided, however, that the whole sum so levied shall not exceed the sum of five thousand dollars, and shall be payable, on the order of said County Commissioners, to the parties respectively entitled to the same.

**Provide additional safeguards.** SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized and required, from the passage of this act, to provide any additional safeguards that may in their discretion be necessary (until the completion of said work) for the safe custody and keeping of prisoners in said jail; and during the repair or rebuilding thereof they may provide additional places for their custody, and shall provide for all such expenses in the annual levy.

**In force.** SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
