

ples of flour there established and collected, to be kept and observed as standards by said inspector herein named.

Insufficient barrels. 71f. In all cases where such inspector may pronounce a flour barrel insufficient, the owner of such barrel, or his agent, may either cause the same to be repaired, or substitute a new one, as the case may require, or he may make such deduction from the price of the flour as may be mutually agreed upon between himself and the purchaser thereof.

Compensat'n 71g. Said inspector shall be entitled to charge and receive for inspecting, weighing and marking each barrel of flour inspected, marked and weighed by him, the sum of one and one-half cents for inspecting, and one cent for weighing each barrel.

Penalty for failure of duty 71h. If said inspector shall wilfully, knowingly and falsely mark the quality or weight of any barrel of flour, he shall forfeit and pay the sum of fifty dollars for every barrel so falsely marked, to be recovered by indictment in the Circuit Court for Allegany county, and his bond may be put in suit by any person or persons injured by any breach of duty committed by him, and such damages, not exceeding the penalty thereof, recovered thereon as the plaintiff in such suits may have sustained by his improper acts.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
