

CHAPTER 402.

AN ACT to repeal the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, chapter two hundred and sixteen, entitled "An act to incorporate the Gwynn's Falls Bridge Company of the Washington Road.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, chapter two hundred and sixteen, entitled "An act relating to the incorporation of the Gwynn's Falls Bridge Company of the Washington Road," be and the same is hereby repealed. Repeal.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said bridge be and the same is hereby declared a free public highway to all intents and purposes, and as such under the care and jurisdiction of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, who shall be chargeable with keeping the same in good order for travel. Free public highway

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 403.

AN ACT to explain certain corporate powers and privileges heretofore conferred, and also to confer additional corporate powers and privileges upon the convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Maryland, by authorizing it to receive by gift, devise or otherwise, contributions in money, land or other property, and to hold the same for the purposes therein mentioned.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the corporate powers and privi-
