

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted,* That nothing in this act shall be construed as to authorize the said company to issue any note, token, script or other evidence of debt to be used as currency; and the General Assembly hereby reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this act, as the public good may require.

Not to issue notes as currency.

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted,* That unless the eight thousand shares of stock herein authorized shall have been subscribed and one-half the par value thereof paid in cash before the year eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, this act shall be deemed void and of no effect, and the General Assembly reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal the same at its pleasure.

CHAPTER 408.

AN ACT to repeal sections one hundred and ninety-three, one hundred and ninety-four, one hundred and ninety-five, one hundred and ninety-six, one hundred and ninety-seven, and one hundred and ninety-eight of article first of the supplement of eighteen hundred and seventy, to the Code of Public Local Laws, under the head of "Allegany county," relating to birds, and to re-enact said sections to read as follows, and to add an additional section thereto to be 98a:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections one hundred and ninety-three, one hundred and ninety-four, one hundred and ninety-five, one hundred and ninety-six, one hundred and ninety-seven, and one hundred and ninety-eight of article first of the supplement of eighteen hundred and seventy, to the Code of
