called in conformity with the original act to which this is a supplement and the by-laws of said company, and thereafter the principal office of said company shall be located in Frostburg.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act, or in the act passed at the December session of eighteen hundred and forty-seven, chapter three hundred and six, entitled "An act to incorporate the Withers Mining Company," shall be so construed as to permit the said Withers Mining Company to construct or subscribe for the stock or bonds of any railroad company other than one leading from the lands of said company to some point on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad or the Cumberland and Pennsylvania Railroad, or the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal at Cumberland.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and the General Assembly hereby reserves the right to alter or amend at pleasure.

CHAPTER 410.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to condemn so much of the property of the State of Maryland fronting on Madison street in the city of Baltimore, being part of the penitentiary ground, as will make the said street of the uniform width of sixty-six feet, and to alter the grades of certain streets in the vicinity.

Whereas the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore are desirous of widening Madison street, in said city, from Forrest to Benson street, on the north side, so as to make it of the uniform width
