CHAPTER 412.

AN ACT granting the assent of the General Assembly of Maryland, to a legacy bequeathed by the last will and testament of Simon Wolf, late of Baltimore county, deceased, to the Church of the Sacred Heart of Jesus at Canton in Baltimore county.

Assent given SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the assent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and is hereby given to the bequest in the last will and testament of Simon Wolf, late of Baltimore county, deceased, to the Church of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, at Canton, in Baltimore county, and Reverend John Hispeline, the pastor of said church, is hereby authorized and empowered to receive said bequest and give due acquittances therefor.

In force SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.
