

Laws, entitled "Licenses," to come in after section twenty-one of said article :

22. *And be it enacted,* That the Mayor of Baltimore city may grant a permit to such number of poor persons as to him may seem proper to peddle within the limits of Baltimore city notions and small ware without a license; provided that, the stock in trade of any such pedlar shall not exceed twenty-five dollars in value, and provided that said mayor may at any time revoke any such permit. Permit to peddle.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 415.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections two, three, eight, nine, ten and eleven of chapter two hundred and thirty-three of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to establish the Maryland House of Correction."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections two, three, eight, nine, ten and eleven of chapter two hundred and thirty-three of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, be and the same are hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows: Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the State Board of Managers shall consist of the following persons: The Board of Public Works, who shall always be State Board of Managers.
