## CHAPTER 415.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections two, three, eight, nine, ten and eleven of chapter two hundred and thirty-three of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to establish the Maryland House of Correction."

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections two, three, eight, nine, ten and eleven of chapter two hundred and thirty-three of the Acts of the General Assembly of Mary-re-enacted. land, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, be and the same are hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:
