

such person shall be punished in such manner as the regulations prescribed by said Board of Managers shall provide, and a record shall be kept of every punishment inflicted and the cause thereof, in a book which shall be kept at the institution, and shall always be laid before the said Board of Managers at its meetings, and it shall be the duty of the Board to exercise a careful supervision and control over the punishments inflicted.

CHAPTER 416.

AN ACT to prevent stock running at large in the second and third election districts of Caroline county, and also to repeal sections eighty-two, eighty-three, eighty-four and eighty-five of the Public Local Laws of Caroline county, sub-title "Fences," so far as they relate to the above election districts.

How ratified. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for stock of any kind to go at large without attendants in the second and third election districts of Caroline county respectively; provided this act shall be adopted by a majority of the qualified voters in said districts in the manner hereinafter provided.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be lawful for any person, and it shall be the duty of the constable of said election districts, to take up any horse, mare or gelding, mule, horned cattle, swine or other stock, which may be found going at large, and without attendants, in either of said election districts,
