session, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, chapter two hundred and fifty-eight, entitled "An act to amend article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled Washington county, by amendre-enact cer- ing and re-enacting certain sections, and adding tain sections, thereto further sections, and to re-enact the same with amendments, so as to elect the Councilmen of Hagerstown by the voters in the respective wards of said town, and to authorize the Justices of the Peace to enforce the ordinances relative to crimes and punishments;" be, and the same are hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

Corporation.

Sec. 109. The inhabitants of Hagerstown, in Washington county, Maryland, are a corporation by the name of "The Mayor and Council of Hagerstown," and by that name shall have perpetual succession; may sue and be sued, may have and use a common seal, and possess such other incidents and attributes as attach by law to a municipal corporation.

Survey.

Sec. 110. The survey made under the authority of the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown, by Samuel S. Downin, surveyor, and adopted by ordinance passed on the eleventh day of June, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-five, and entered upon the records of their proceedings, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Washington county, in Liber number seventy-three, folios four hundred and seventy-seven and four hundred and seventy-eight, one of the Land Records of Washington county, Maryland, and the map of Hagerstown, inserted in said book of records, next preceding the record of said survey, shall constitute the Bounds and bounds and limits of said fown, and the said map limits of town and record of survey shall be received as evidence of the limits and boundaries of the said town, and the wards, lots, streets, lanes and alleys thereof. Provided, however, that for sanitary and police purposes the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown shall have and exercise full power and control for a distance of one-half mile in every direction from said corporate limits.

Sec. 111. The male citizens of Hagerstown of the age of twenty-one years and upwards, who have re-
