

What is un-  
lawful

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to stop their horses or any other animal, carts, wagons or any other vehicle in any public or private road, or any other place within the distance of one-half mile beyond and surrounding the grounds belonging to and controlled by the said corporation, during any fair or exhibition conducted and carried on under the auspices of the same, any longer time than is absolutely necessary in the transaction of their legitimate business, or for any person or persons to violate any of the provisions of this act, or any of the rules, regulations and enactments of the said association not inconsistent with the laws of this State.

Penalty for  
violation.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That any person or persons who shall knowingly and wilfully violate any of the provisions of this act, or any of the by-laws, rules, regulations or other enactments of the said association not inconsistent with the laws of this State, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before any justice of the peace of the said county, each and every person so offending shall be fined by said justice of the peace a sum not less than one dollar, nor more than five dollars for the first offence, and not less than five dollars nor more than twenty dollars for each and every offence committed thereafter; and upon the failure of any person or persons to pay the said fines, together with all the costs attending their arrest and conviction, the justice of the peace before whom the same may be tried shall commit them to the county jail in said county until the said fines and costs are paid.

Fines—how  
disposed of.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That all fines imposed and collected under and in accordance with this act, shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Board of School Commissioners of Wicomico county, for the use and benefit of the public schools in said county.

Special con-  
stables.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That all persons summoned and detailed in accordance with the fifth section of this act, shall be known, recognized and respected as "Special Constables," and shall have full power, authority and jurisdiction in the discharge of their several duties within the fair grounds and
