CHAPTER 424.

AN ACT to protect diamond-back terrapins in the waters of the State of Maryland, and to regulate the catching of the same.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person to take or catch diamond-back terrapins from the waters of this State between the first day of April and the first day of November in each

Size to take

SEC. 2. Be it enacted, That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take or catch from the waters of this State any diamond-back terrapin of a less size than five inches in length, upon the bottom shell, at any time.
