CHAPTER 427.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, sections forty-nine and fifty-one of article thirty-five of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Elections," sub-title "Special Elections."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections forty-nine and fifty-one of article thirty-five of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Elections," sub-title "Special Elections," be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following be enacted in lieu thereof:

Repealed and enacted in lieu.

SEC. 49. Warrants for all special elections shall be issued to the sheriff of the county or city where the election is to be held, who shall appoint a day for the holding of the same, and shall give at least ten days' notice thereof, exclusive of the day of publication and day of election, by advertisements set up at the most public places within each district of the county, and by advertisements in two newspapers of general circulation in such county. In the city of Baltimore ten days' previous notice shall be given in the manner herein prescribed of all special elections, whether for federal, State or municipal officers.

SEC. 51. Such elections shall be held within fifteen days after the warrant shall be received by the sheriff.
