

dents, privileges and immunities and liabilities, including the right to vote in person or by proxy for the election of directors of said company, and for all other purposes, to which the capital stock of said company or the holders thereof may be entitled or subject; provided, however, that the said company shall not exercise any power under this act unless the creation of the said preferred stock shall be authorized by a general meeting of the stockholders of the said company.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 429.

AN ACT to pay to Joshua Jones, of St. Mary's county, the sum of thirty-four dollars, amount paid the State by said Jones for license to carry on the business of retail liquor dealer, said license being suppressed a few weeks thereafter by orders of the General Government.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant to the Treasurer to pay Joshua Jones, of St. Mary's county, the sum of thirty-four dollars, being the sum paid by said Jones in eighteen hundred and sixty-four, for license as retail liquor dealer at Forestville, in said county, said license being suppressed a few weeks after the issuing the same by order of the General Government.
