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CHAPTER 433.

AN ACT to regulate the fees of the State's Attorney for Calvert county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the State's Attorney for Carroll county shall receive the following fees, to be paid by the County Commissioners of said county: In cases punishable by confinement in the penitentiary, where an indictment is found, ten dollars; in all other criminal cases, where an indictment is found, five dollars; said fees to be in addition to the appearance fees now allowed by law. 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CHAPTER 434.

AN ACT to pay Isaac M. Denson a balance due for cement furnished for the use of the State to Thos. H. Moore, late Weigher of Live Stock.
