CHAPTER 435.

AN ACT to refund John F. Price, guardian of Catherine S. McIntire, of Cecil county, a sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury.

Refund money erroneously paid SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer in favor of John F. Price, of Cecil county, guardian of Catherine S. McIntire, for the sum of thirty dollars and eighty cents, erroneously paid into the Treasury of the State by John R. Price, former guardian of the said Catherine S. McIntire.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
