

town ordinances tried before the two police justices, setting forth the name of the offender, his offence, amount of fine and costs or other penalty, all of which shall be reported to the Mayor by the officer making such arrest immediately thereafter.

**Ordinances to be approv'd** SEC. 115. All ordinances passed by the Council shall be sent to the Mayor for his approbation, and upon his approval shall become laws, but in case he return any ordinance without his sanction it shall not become a law unless passed subsequently by four out of the five councilmen.

SEC. 116. For his services the Mayor shall receive an annual salary of two hundred dollars and no other fees whatever.

**How divided.** SEC. 117. The said town shall be divided into five wards, as indicated on Downin's map of Hagerstown aforesaid, and there shall be five councilmen, one from each ward, possessed of the following qualifications: They shall be twenty-five years of age, citizens of the United States, residents of Hagerstown for five years next preceding the election, and possessed of property assessed at not less than five hundred dollars, situate within said town, and residents of the respective wards from which they are chosen for six months next preceding their election.

**When elected** SEC. 118. The said councilmen shall be elected on the fourth Monday of March in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, and the councilmen for wards one, three and five shall continue in office until the fourth Monday of March in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, or until their successors are elected and qualify, when there shall be an election for councilmen in said wards, and from that time, upon the same day in every alternate year, there shall be an election for councilmen in said wards; the councilmen elect in eighteen hundred and seventy-eight for wards two and four shall continue in office until eighteen hundred and eighty, or until their successors are elected and qualify, when, at the mayoralty election in said year, there shall be an election for councilmen in said wards, and from that time forth, upon the same day in every alternate
