SEC. 21. *And be it enacted*, That the Mayor and City Council shall determine what was high water mark before the construction of the basin of the Tidewater canal. Determine high water mark.

SEC. 22. *And be it enacted*, That if any person aggrieved by the decision of the Mayor and City Council in fixing the line or point of high water mark, may at any time within one year appeal to the Circuit Court for Harford county, and said court shall hear testimony and review the decision. Right of appeal.

SEC. 23. *And be it enacted*, That the Mayor and City Council shall cause a registration to be made of all the voters of the city, which registration shall be completed on or before the second Wednesday in December, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine. It shall be the duty of the clerk to the Council to act without extra compensation as register. He shall give fifteen days' notice of the time and place when he shall sit for the registration of voters, and shall set apart days from time to time by giving sufficient notice, so that all citizens who are entitled to vote may have an opportunity to be registered. He shall also open the registration books in each and every year at least one week previous to the day of election, for the purpose of adding new names and correcting the register list, and shall keep open his books for one day from nine o'clock in the morning until six o'clock in the evening, and it shall be the duty of said clerk acting as register, to register all those who shall furnish satisfactory proof, upon oath or otherwise, that they are upwards of twenty-one years of age and citizens of the United States; that they have been residents of the State of Maryland for one year, and have *bona fide* resided within the limits of said city for one year. Voters to be registered.

Open registration books every year.

SEC. 24. *And be it enacted*, That the Mayor and City Council shall once in every seven years, or oftener if they think proper, appoint two assessors, who shall value and assess the property in said cor- Appoint assessors.
