

Summon jury SEC. 38. *And be it enacted*, That whenever the said City Council shall by ordinance order the opening of any new street in said city, they shall summon a jury of twelve disinterested male citizens of said city, whom for that purpose the Mayor shall have summoned and sworn, to determine, upon a view of the premises, the amount of damages due to the owner of the land through which said street shall pass; and the said jury so summoned and sworn shall return under their seals to the Mayor of said city the amount and result of their findings; and such damages so found shall be paid out of the treasury of said city.

Qualifications. SEC. 39. *And be it enacted*, That the City Council shall be the judges of the qualifications of the Mayor, and of their own members.

Quorum. SEC. 40. *And be it enacted*, That four members of the City Council shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and the Council shall pass all needful rules for their government whilst in session.

How decided SEC. 41. *And be it enacted*, That in case of a tie vote in the City Council upon any question whatever, the Mayor shall have the right to vote, and shall decide the question in dispute.

May appoint counsel. SEC. 42. *And be it enacted*, That the Mayor and City Council, if they shall deem it necessary, may appoint counsel to the corporation, and may allow said counsel such compensation as they may think proper for services performed by their request, not exceeding fifty dollars per annum.

Who is to call an election. SEC. 43. *And be it enacted*, That J. Thompson Freize, A. E. Treadway, Robert Seneca, Jacob Osmond and Robert R. Vandiver, Commissioners of the town of Havre-de-Grace, or a majority of them, are hereby authorized to call an election on the first Monday in January, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, to elect a Mayor and six members of the City Council, under this act. They shall first give three weeks' notice of such election, previous to the first Monday in January, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, in some newspaper published in said town, or
