CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and seventy-four of the Acts of Assembly, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, and entitled an act to add additional sections to article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to be known as sections eighty-seven A, eighty-seven B, eighty-seven C, eighty-seven D, eighty-seven E, eighty-seven F, eighty-seven G, eighty-seven H, eighty-seven I, eighty-seven I, eighty-seven L, eighty-seven L, eighty-seven M, eighty-seven N, eighty-seven O, eighty-seven P, eighty-seven Q, eighty-seven R, eighty-seven S, eighty-seven T," and re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter two hundred and seventy-four of the Acts of Assembly, passed at Repealed and January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, re-enacted. be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 87 A. And be it enacted, That the County Commissioners shall, when they make their levy, specify therein what per centum is levied for school Specify purposes, what per centum for bonded indebtedness centum of said county, what per centum for almshouse purposes, what per centum for court purposes, and what per centum for general purposes, which latter shall include all matters not embraced under any of the preceding headings.
