

allow him all fines and forfeitures recovered for the violation of the town ordinances, and no more. The said bailiff shall enforce the ordinances of said town, and in the execution of the duties of his office shall have all and the same powers as constables in criminal cases; the said bailiff, before entering upon the duties of his office, shall make oath before one of the said commissioners that he will faithfully and impartially execute the duties of his office according to the best of his skill and judgment, without favor or prejudice, and shall also give bond to the State of Maryland in such penalty as the commissioners may direct, and with sureties to be by them approved, for the faithful performance of his duties as bailiff, and the said bond shall be recorded in the office of the clerk of the Circuit Court for Worcester county; but nothing herein shall be construed to prevent the bailiff from also acting as lamplighter, and receiving the additional pay in said capacity.

Oath to be administered.

Give bond.

Erect lamps and lamp-posts.

SEC. 22. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners shall erect lamps and lamp-posts at such places in said town as they may think proper, and shall appoint a lamplighter to attend to the lighting and keeping the lamps in order, and shall allow the said lamplighter for his services the sum of seventy-five dollars.

Extend or change limits

SEC. 23. The said commissioners shall have power to extend or otherwise change the limits of said town whenever they shall deem it expedient.

Powers.

SEC. 24. *And be it enacted*, That all said commissioners may pass all ordinances necessary to give effect and operation to the powers vested in them.

How made public.

SEC. 25. *And be it enacted*, That all ordinances enacted by the said commissioners shall be immediately made public by printed handbills posted in not less than five conspicuous places in said town.

Who are commissioners.

SEC. 26. *And be it enacted*, That the five commissioners now in office shall remain and continue to be commissioners of Snow Hill until the first
