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CHAPTER 444.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of Sisson & Son, Basshor & Co., Harrington & Mills, Renwick & Son, Jenkins & Son, George W. Taylor, Cornelius & Co., Louis A. Dieter, Shirley & Son, Emmart & Quartley, Dyott Manufacturing Company, Fairbanks, Murphy & Co., J. C. Knipp & Bro., Samuel Child & Co., and McDowell & Co.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer to pay Sisson & Son, thirty-two dollars and twenty-seven cents; Basshor & Co., thirty-two dollars and forty cents; Harrington & Mills, five thousand seven hundred and forty-four dollars and forty-six cents; Renwick & Son, two thousand five hundred and sixteen dollars and fifty cents; Jenkins & Son, eight hundred and fifty-one dollars; George W.
