SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall In force take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 447.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Trustees of the Cavetown Union School-house, in Washington county, to sell and convey said property and execute a good and sufficient deed for the same.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Joseph Winters, David Spessard, Joshua Dayhoff, Jr., John Houser, John E. Kelly, John J. Houser and Oliver J. Beard, Trustees of the Cavetown Union School-house, and their successors, be and they are hereby authorized and empowerd to sell, dispose of, convey and execute a to sell, &c deed for said property, it being the same property heretofore conveyed by deed from John Winters and Margaret, his wife, to seven trustees of said schoolhouse, and their successors, of whom the several persons herein named as trustees are the successors aforesaid.
