

CHAPTER 456.

AN ACT to authorize the cession of the Cumberland Turnpike road, or any portion thereof, to the County Commissioners of Allegany and Washington counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the president, managers and company of the Cumberland Turnpike road be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to cede to the County Commissioners of Allegany and Washington counties, respectively, such parts of the turnpike road of the said president, managers and company of the Cumberland turnpike road as lie within the said counties respectively, upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon between the said turnpike corporation and the County Commissioners to whom any such cession shall be made, and such turnpike road or part thereof, when so ceded, shall be used and treated in all respects as other public roads of the county or respective counties within which the same may lie.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That every such cession shall be made by deed, to be executed, acknowledged and recorded according to law by the president, managers and company of the Cumberland Turnpike road, in the same manner as deeds are required to be executed, acknowledged and recorded, to pass real estate.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the president, managers and company of the Cumberland Turnpike road aforesaid be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey any or all toll houses or other property of the said corporation, and also any land of said corporation not lying within the limits of their turnpike road.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That any cession which shall be made under this act shall not impair or effect the right of said turnpike corporation to collect tolls for the use of the portions of said turnpike road not so ceded.
