

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That whenever the president, managers and company of the Cumberland Turnpike road aforesaid shall, by a vote of the stockholders holding a majority of the stock of the said corporation, resolve and determine that the said corporation shall be dissolved, the said corporation shall thereupon be dissolved accordingly, and be deemed to have surrendered its corporate rights, privileges and franchises. How dissolved.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

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CHAPTER 457.

AN ACT to give and declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the several bequests of the Rev. John Crosdale, D. D., late of Worcester county, deceased, to the Convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Easton, State of Maryland, as Trustees of Pocomoke Parish, in said diocese; and also to the bequest of three hundred dollars to the Convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Easton, State of Maryland, as Trustees for Coventry Parish, in said diocese, as contained and designated in the last will and testament of the said Rev. John Crosdale, D. D., deceased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given and declared to the several bequests of various sums of money to the Convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Easton, Sanction given to bequests.
