

other elections held in this State, under penalty, in case of neglect or refusal to perform such duty as is now provided in the election laws of this State.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That said election shall be held in accordance with the law governing general elections in this State, at which said election the ballots to be cast shall have printed or written on them "For license," or "Against license," and the ballots so cast shall be received by the judges of election and deposited in a separate box provided for the purpose by the said sheriff, at the expense of said county, and counted by them, who shall, within three days thereafter, make a written return of the same under their hands and seals, and of the number of ballots so cast for or against license, to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for said county, who shall record the same; and it shall be the duty of said clerk, within ten days after said election, to cause to be printed and published in one or more newspapers published in said county once a week for two successive weeks, a proclamation of the result of such election in each of said districts of the county aforesaid.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That if it shall be found at such election, and proclaimed by the said clerk of court, that a majority of the qualified votes have been cast "For license" in any of the said election districts wherein the sale of liquors or other fermented spirits is now prohibited by law, immediately after the proclamation by the said clerk of the result of said election, such prohibition shall be and is hereby removed; and any and every person may proceed to sell liquor or other fermented spirits in such election district upon obtaining license therefor as is now or hereafter may be provided by Public General or Public Local Law, as the case may be; and the Comptroller of the Treasury shall, on application, issue his license therefor for the balance of the license year ending May first in the year succeeding said election, and regularly thereafter until a change is made in the *status* of the law as to such election district as hereinafter provided in this act; provided that such person shall in addition to such license, to be obtained as aforesaid from the Comptroller, also obtain a license from the Clerk of the Circuit Court
