

dwelling houses of said Adam Clark and John Baird, and including all the lots now improved and lots laid out for building purposes on both sides of the street, and including the machine shop and grounds of William T. Haugh, and one hundred feet of the northern part of George A. Flickinger's lot, known as "The Lime Kiln Lot," and all the lots on the northern part of said street as far as the road commonly known as the "Mill Road," and then starting at the southwest corner of the Catholic Church lot and running along said street to the northeast corner of Jacob Lambert's lot, including all the lots on both sides of the streets; and for sanitary purposes and to prevent the introduction of contagious diseases, the powers of the corporation shall extend to the distance of one mile from the outside limits of the corporation herein described.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the male citizens of Taneytown above twenty-one years of age, who shall have resided in said town twelve months next preceding the election shall, on the third Monday in April, annually, elect five commissioners, each one of whom shall be thirty-five years of age, residents of and holding real or personal property in said town above the value of five hundred dollars, and in case of a tie vote at any election, the President of the Board of Commissioners shall give ten days' notice of a new election, to decide the choice between them.

Elect commissioners.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That all elections shall be held by one or more judges, in such manner as shall from time to time be directed by ordinance of the corporation, and the polls shall be kept open from one o'clock until four o'clock P. M.

Elections—how held.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That if the inhabitants of said town shall, at any time, neglect to make an election at the time herein required, the power of electing the commissioners shall not therefore cease, but the power of said inhabitants in that respect shall continue, and the commissioners for the time being shall continue in office until such election shall be held and their successors are qualified.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That in case of the death, refusal to act, disqualification, resignation, or
