for the violation of any rules, ordinances, regulations and by-laws be made in the name of the Commissioners of Laurel against offending parties, and all fines recovered in such suits at law for the breach of any rule, ordinance, regulation or by-law of the corporation, before any justice of the peace for Prince George's county, shall be collected by said justice of the peace and paid over to the treasurer of said corporation within three months after the collection of the same, and the said justice of the peace shall render an account to the commissioners every three months, or oftener if required, the amount so received by him.

SEC. 53. And be it enacted, That the said commissioners shall have power to appoint annually a supervisor, and may or may not appoint one of their pervisor. number, whose duty it shall be to superintend such improvements of the town as may be ordered by the commissioners, or a majority of them, and such other duties as they may prescribe, and the said commissioners may allow him such compensation for his services as they may think proper, and may remove him at pleasure.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.
