children; provided, however, that none of the provisions of this act shall be construed so as to prevent children from selling or offering for sale newspapers.

Sec. 933. Any person or persons representing himself, herself or themselves to be, or passing himself, herself or themselves off as, the parent or guardian of a child, or children, referred to in guilty of misany of the aforesaid sections of this act, and it shall appear that such person is not either the parent or guardian of said child, such person or persons shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction by any court of competent jurisdiction, shall be fined not more than twenty dollars and costs for each and every offence.

CHAPTER 474.

Baltimore," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:
