

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That the said County Commissioners shall, as soon as possible, procure and adopt a plan and specifications for said building, and they shall invite sealed proposals by publication for a reasonable time for the building of said jail, and the contract for building said jail shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, who shall be required to give a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of his contract, and the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized to sell and dispose of the present jail, and the proceeds arising therefrom shall be applied to the payment and retirement of the bonds.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 477.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and fifty-four to section one hundred and eighty-four, inclusive, of article ten of the Public Local Laws for Dorchester county, entitled "Roads;" also, to repeal section one hundred and eighty-five, enacted in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional section to the Public Local Laws of Dorchester county," article ten, and to enact the following sections in lieu thereof:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections one hundred and fifty-four to one hundred and eighty-four, inclusive, of article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester county," sub-title "Roads," and section one hundred and eighty-five of the same, as enacted by
