CHAPTER 481.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of Medairy and Bowers for stationery furnished for the use of the General Assembly and Court of Appeals and the State Library.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby requested and directed to issue his warrant upon the State Treasurer to pay Medairy and Bowers for stationery furnished for the use of the General Assembly for this present session the sum Issuewarrant of five thousand seven hundred and twenty-three dollars and thirty-five cents, and for stationery furnished the State Library the sum of three hundred and ninety-nine dollars and thirty cents, and for stationery furnished the Court of Appeals the sum of nine hundred and thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents.

SEC. 2. Be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 482.

AN ACT to authorize the Comptroller to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay John A. Gillam, of Allegany county, the sum of three hundred dollars, with interest, bounty due him since eighteen hundred and sixty-five.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay John A. Gillam, of Allegany county, private in Company C, 2d Regiment,

Pay bounty due.
