#### CHAPTER 494.

AN ACT to repeal sections three, four, five, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, and fourteen of an act passed at January session of the Legislature, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter one hundred and seventy-nine, entitled "An act to repeal section fifty-five to sixty-four, inclusive, of the Public Local Laws of Baltimore county, entitled 'Collector,' and section seventy-eight to ninety, inclusive, entitled 'Treasurer,' and enact the following, entitled 'Treasurer and Collector,' in lieu thereof," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections three, four, five, ten, eleven, twelve and fourteen of chapter one hundred and seventy-nine, laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled "An act to repeal section fifty-five to sixty-four inclusive, of the Public Local Laws of Baltimore county, entitled 'Collector,' and section seventy-eight to ninety inclusive, entitled 'Treasurer,' and enact the following, entitled 'Treasurer and Collector,' in lieu thereof," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows :
